# (nominations now open! RAYTHEON LEADERS IN EDUCATION AWARD

Do you know a fabulous teacher who deserves to be recognized? Then nominate them for the **2024 Raytheon Leaders in Education Award**!

Please note the process for this award has changed this year and requires teachers to be nominated prior to applying. The <u>Raytheon Leaders in Education Award</u>, in partnership with Tucson Values Teachers, is designed to recognize the contributions of Pima County teachers. The program honors four exceptionally skilled and dedicated teachers in grades PreK (Early Childhood) through 12 in all content areas. Nominees are teachers who have gained the respect and admiration of students, parents, and colleagues, and who inspire students of all backgrounds and abilities to learn. They distinguish themselves as leaders and play an active and useful role in their communities and in their schools.

Eligibility to receive the award include:

- 1. Spend the majority (over 50%) of the school day in direct instruction to students.
- 2. Be currently certified to teach Arizona.
- 3. Have completed at least four full years as a classroom teacher at the same time the application is submitted for consideration.
- 4. Teach any grade or combination of grades Pre-K through 12 in a school in Pima County.

Teachers may be nominated by **anyone**: colleagues, administrators, parents, students, family members, organizations, or they may self-nominate.

The deadline for all nomination submissions is 5pm on May 12, 2024. Please note multiple nominations for one person does not increase their chance of winning.

# Submit Teacher Excellence Award video nominations by April 15



Students are invited to submit <u>video nominations</u> for the Teacher Excellence Award. We'll select five winners and surprise teachers during Teacher Appreciation Week, running May 6 through May 10.

All PreK-12 Southern Arizona teachers in Pima, Cochise, and Santa Cruz counties are eligible to be nominated. Students can submit a nomination individually or work together and submit as a group. Parents, administrators, and other adults may help students.

To submit a nomination, students need to:

- 1. Create a video explaining why their teacher should be honored with a Teacher Excellence Award. Videos must be no longer than 60 seconds and available in MP4 or MOV formats.
- 2. Fill out a brief nomination form that includes a *public* link to download the video.

Nominations are currently open and will close on April 15.

## Congratulations to our March Teacher Excellence Award winner, Jose Noperi Jr.!

Mr. Noperi is a 6th grade math teacher at Valencia Middle School in Tucson Unified School District. Mr. Noperi was nominated by his colleague, Briana Gomez.

In her nominating statement, she wrote, "Mr. Noperi has been at the school for 12 years and, even though I have only been his colleague for 7 of them, watching his interactions with students who have come

back to our school (or who work at businesses in our area) has confirmed to me that he is a staple of our school community. His ability to bond with the children using humor and tough love helps their social interactions and helps him emphasize the importance of accountability, good work ethic and critical thinking skills.

"Not only is he an incredible math teacher (who has helped our math scores for sixth grade outperform our 7th/8th grade scores), he has also been our girls soccer coach for the past 7 years and has made tremendous strides towards improving their self-confidence, resiliency, and team building skills. I think that, out of everyone at our school who deserves recognition for the work and dedication we give to our students, it's his time to shine. He doesn't go out of his way to apply for anything and no one has sincerely given him the credit he deserves for all the effort and work he's put in over the past decade+, so I'm nominating Mr. Noperi for this recognition."

# 2023 Arizona Educator Profession Survey report now available




In 2023, Tucson Values Teachers, Tucson Regional Educator Collaborative (TREC), and the University of Arizona College of Education once again developed a survey to explore the needs and resources for educators in the region by determining the accessibility of professional development and support opportunities and overall educator perspectives on job satisfaction, financial obligations, and teacher identity.

A report of findings from this survey was recently published. The report in its entirety can be found <u>here</u>. Below are key findings:

- **50 percent of educators feel satisfied in their profession** and a majority of educators reported feeling that their presence has a positive effect on the school environment. When asked what benefits were most important to educators, dental insurance, a safe school space, and a family friendly work schedule were by far emphasized as most important.
- Approximately two-thirds of educators do not know or would not recommend becoming an educator to other people. Many educators reported overwhelming workloads, lack of societal respect, and low pay as reasons for this. Twenty-five percent of educators reported preparations to leave the profession within 3-5 years.
- Active student participation/student engagement, social/emotional learning, project-based learning, and classroom management/behavior guidance were listed as the top four sought out professional learning opportunities educators would benefit from.


