Educator Celebration






We love to celebrate our teachers!

Updates from TREC



Applications for the TREC Teacher Leader Program — Cohort 5 are now open!

The <u>TREC Teacher Leader Program</u> is a cohort-based opportunity for birth-12th grade educators to build key leadership competencies, create spaces to reflect on their instructional practices, and provide social/emotional support for their fellow teachers.

This program is a core feature of TREC — a partnership of Tucson-area schools, districts, community organizations, and the University of Arizona — and is designed to promote high-quality professional learning that is both made for and led by classroom educators.

TREC seeks to build cohorts that reflect the diversity of identities and experiences present in the Tucson educator community, and consist of teachers who are, or are motivated to become, leaders in their schools and districts.

Who should apply to the TREC Teacher Leader Program?

TREC is looking for 10 – 12 birth-12th grade teachers who have three or more years of teaching experience and spend at least 50% of their contract time teaching students in a classroom setting.



TREC and The Center of Recruitment and Retention of Mathematics Teachers (CRR) have partnered together for this four-part <u>Math for Early Learners Series!</u>

They will focus on supporting early childhood educators to bring math topics such as Numbers & Cardinality, Measurement, Geometry, Algebraic Thinking, and Data Analysis into their classrooms. This series can be viewed as individual sessions, but the greatest understanding and connections will be made by attending as many as possible.
