Teacher Voices: Impacts of COVID-19

Expect More Arizona, in cooperation with the State Board of Education,

conducted a <u>survey</u> of K-12 teachers between May 20-31 to find out how the COVID-19 pandemic impacted teaching in spring 2020 and to learn about teacher concerns for the upcoming school year.

Survey Details


Nearly 11,000 teachers from across the state completed the survey. Expect More Arizona has released Phase 1 results, focusing on teacher concerns and priorities for when schools reopen in August. Results can be found in the infographic below or at Expect More Arizona's website.

NEARLY 80% OF TEACHERS INTEND TO RETURN TO THE CLASSROOM AT THE START OF THE SCHOOL YEAR



- 1. HEALTH AND SAFETY OF STAFF (67%) AND STUDENTS (62%)
- 2. STUDENT MENTAL HEALTH (37%)
- 3. HELPING STUDENTS CATCH UP (35%)



TOP STRATEGIES TEACHERS RECOMMEND TO HELP STUDENTS CATCH UP

- 1.FOCUS ON CORE ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS AND MATH AREAS (46%)
- 2.PROVIDE 1-ON-1 OR SMALL GROUP INSTRUCTION (41%)
- 3. FOCUS ON SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING (37%)
- 4.HIGH QUALITY CURRICULUM (36%)




