TUCSON VALUES TEACHERS CELEBRATES TUCSON ELECTRIC POWER'S \$100,000 CONTRIBUTION TO ANNUAL SUPPLY DRIVE

TUCSON, Ariz. – Representatives from Tucson Values Teachers and Tucson Electric Power (TEP) celebrated TEP's \$100,000 donation to Tucson Supplies Teachers, an annual supply drive, with a check presentation this morning at Laguna Elementary School. In addition to formally recognizing TEP's continued support of Tucson Supplies Teachers, the presentation included awarding all teachers at Laguna with a \$50 gift card to Office Depot/OfficeMax.

With TEP's \$100,000 contribution, the fall 2019 Tucson Supplies Teachers drive was able to raise \$111,500 worth of gift cards for K-12 teachers in Southern Arizona to use for classroom materials and supplies. Tucson Supplies Teachers is the largest school supply drive in the region and the only regional supply drive that directly invests in teachers and allows educators to shop for their specific classroom needs. Tucson Supplies Teachers has delivered more than \$1.1 million worth of school supplies since its inception in 2009.
